

DEFENDANT'S TO DO LIST

Bring the following information needed for your defense to your next appointment:

- Letters of support from an organized activity (community service, church, YMCA, volunteer work etc.)
- AA/NA sign in sheets
- Proof of residence
- Letter of support from landlord
- Phone bill
- Rent receipt
- Literature from the halfway house
- Completed assessments
- Documentation of your acceptance into a treatment program
- Brochure or literature about the treatment facility you are attending
- Pay stubs
- Letter of support from your employer
- Worksheet from debt counseling
- Medical records
- Statement from your doctor
- A plan for transportation to and from the probation office
- Immigration papers
- Letter from family member with whom you will reside outside the state
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Do the following, which is critical for your defense:

- Enroll and attend an organized activity
- Identify and ask character references to come to court with you
- Identify your psychologist/counselor, frequency of visits, and goals of treatment.
- Arrange for a phone to be installed in your residence
- Bring money for restitution to court.
- Contact the local literacy council and identify an instructor
- Enroll in process to get your GED
- Seek debt counseling from _____ (phone) _____
- Seek a substance abuse evaluation from _____ (phone) _____
- Put together clothing suitable for court (clean long sleeve white shirt, tie, no jewelry)
