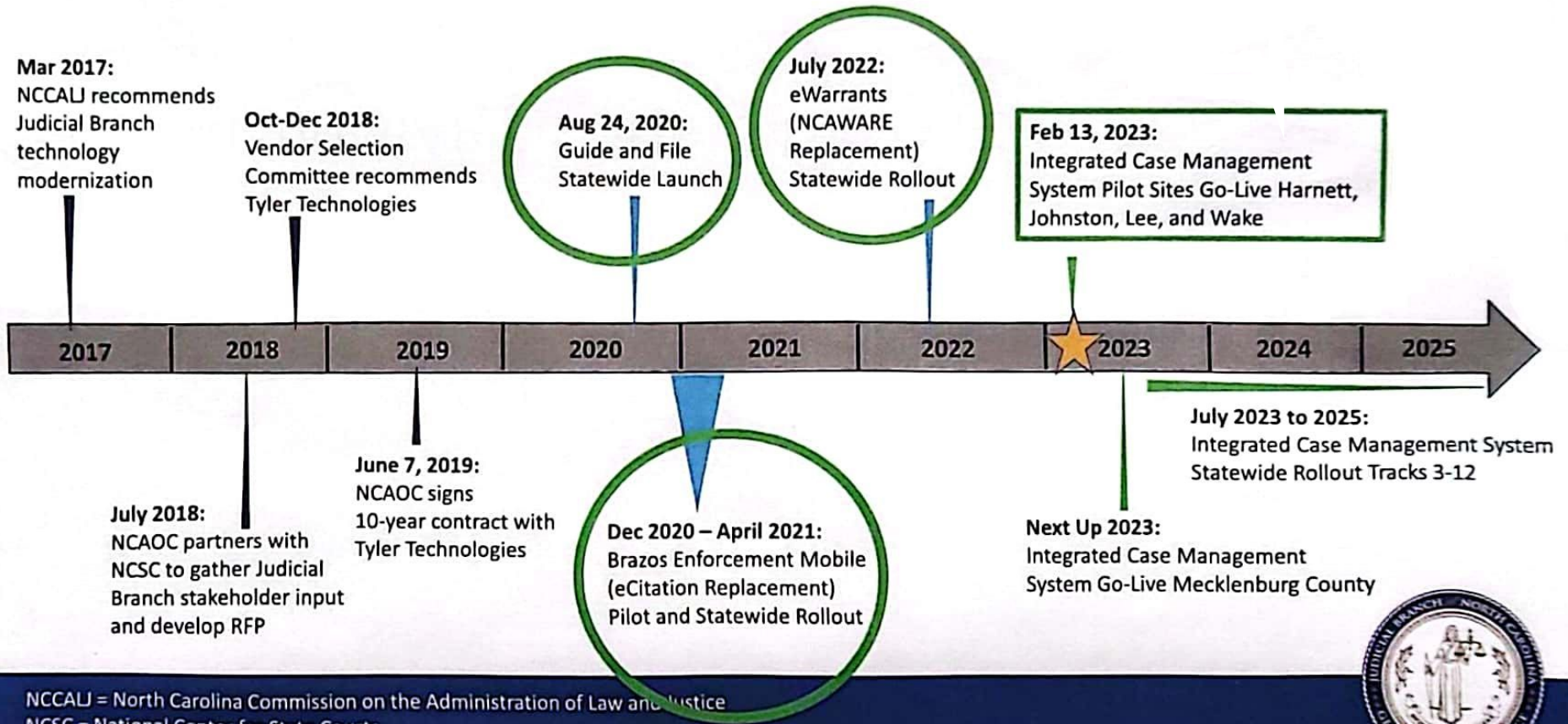

REDACTION IMPROVEMENTS

Privacy laws are slowing or prohibiting internet access to court records.

- AOC is providing additional guidance and training to clerk offices concerning redaction.
- AOC is pursuing legislation that would clarify clerks' authority to redact legally-protected PII in court files.
- AOC is removing PII from many AOC forms.
- Request for removal of PII from forms posted on Portal can be submitted to the Clerk of Superior Court via an AOC-A-250.

CITATIONS TO APPEAR ON PORTAL

- This summer, the integration between Brazos and Odyssey will be modified so that citations appear on Portal when received by Odyssey. This will remove the current step of Clerks needing to take action on each citation for them to appear on Portal.
- Officer notes will be displayed on the citation in Odyssey and Portal.



SYSTEM SPEED ISSUES

- AOC continually monitoring system speed and availability issues.
- Tyler continues to “tune” the server environment to optimize speed.
- Tyler is investigating and resolving script errors that cause data entry delays and duplicative work.
- Notable improvement in last week.
- AOC is developing a plan to explore additional “tokens” for judgments and other forms to auto-populate information and reduce clerk data entry time.
- AOC and courthouse staff continue to review and adjust business processes and workflows to increase efficiency.



DATA INTEGRATIONS

- AOC began working with external agencies (GDAC, DMV, OST, DOR) several years ago to develop integrations to avoid interruptions in data exchange after the eCourts transition.
- AOC completed most of these integrations prior to Odyssey go-live and will finalize the OST and DOR integrations this spring (OST/DOR integrations affect internal bookkeeping).
- In mid-March, AOC discovered an integration error that transmitted incorrect speeds to DMV in approximately 20 speeding citations. AOC and DMV promptly resolved the error and notified each affected driver via mail.
- AOC is unaware of any other external integration defects but meets regularly with external agencies and actively monitors each integration.



COURT NOTIFICATIONS

- AOC is working to improve eCourts notification and service functionality.
 - Attorneys would have single, statewide "service address of record with the court" collected by the NC State Bar and auto-integrated into Odyssey for purposes of notice and service.
 - Legislative efforts affecting Chapter 84 and N.C. R. Civ. P., Rule 5.
 - Enhancements with NC State Bar records.
 - Court officials will be able to serve Notices and Orders via Odyssey-generated email notifications to attorneys.
