



AUGUST UPDATE: PAC FUND

August 8, 2025

PAC payments resumed July 1, 2025, under the continuing budget resolution put in place because the General Assembly recessed prior to passing a comprehensive FY25-26 budget.

The General Assembly did reconvene later in July and passed a “mini budget” addressing some urgent state operational needs. We are pleased to report that the mini budget included **\$10 million** in additional PAC funding for the current fiscal year.

As is the case each fiscal year, payments are subject to the availability of funds. However, IDS believes that this additional funding is sufficient to keep the PAC solvent for the entire fiscal year.

Absent unforeseeable circumstances, IDS does not foresee any slowdowns in PAC payments through June 30, 2026.

We will continue with monthly updates to keep you informed. As always, thank you for the work you do on behalf of your clients.

Staff continue working to ensure that payments to you remain at no more than 45 days from receipt of the fee app(s) in Raleigh.

Who can I contact if 60 days have passed and I haven't been paid?

Please contact the IDS Financial Services staff member assigned to your county. Please have the case name, case number, disposition date, the date submitted to the judge, and your tax identification number on hand when you call.

If you have several cases to research, email is best.
