



*APRIL UPDATE: PAC FUND*

April 8, 2026

IDS and the North Carolina state government continue to operate under the terms of the continuing budget resolution.

Based on current trends in PAC spending and on the uncertainty about receipts, it is **possible** that the PAC fund will be depleted prior to the end of the fiscal year ending June 30.

**IDS expects that PAC fund availability will last into June, and any disruption to payments should be brief.**

We will continue with a monthly update to keep you informed. As always, thank you for the work you do on behalf of your clients.
